Automatically connect to Wi-Fi networks in Starbucks locations across the United States; simply ensure your BlackBerry® Bold™ smartphone Wi-Fi radio is turned on.

To scan for available Wi-Fi® networks, complete the following steps:

- From the homescreen, click **BlackBerry Setup**.
- Click **Set Up Wi-Fi**.
- Click **Scan For Networks**.
- If prompted, click **Turn Wi-Fi on**.
- From the list of available Wi-Fi networks, click the appropriate Wi-Fi network.
- Specify the required security credentials and click **Connect**.
- To save the Wi-Fi network connection as a profile, click **Yes** in the Save this Wi-Fi Network as a Profile field.
- Type a profile name in the Profile Name field and click **Next**.
- Click **Finish** to complete the connection to an available Wi-Fi network.

Note: The BlackBerry Bold smartphone can connect to a Wi-Fi network without saving that Wi-Fi network connection as a profile. However, each subsequent connection to that Wi-Fi network will require the BlackBerry Bold smartphone user to complete Set Up Wi-Fi.

- BlackBerry® smartphone Software v4.5—helping you do more with the BlackBerry smartphone you already own.
- 4.5 offers Mobile Streaming which helps you to access videos, music or even sports and news clips from supported mobile streaming websites.¹ The built-in mobile streaming capabilities of the BlackBerry Bold smartphone is designed so that you can watch online videos or listen to streamed music broadcasts.
- Public and semi-public hotspots usually employ a captive portal for network security and do not require security credentials at this step in the process.
- The security credentials or payment options required by captive portals vary. Contact the network administrator for more information.

To manually add a Wi-Fi network, complete the following steps:

- From the homescreen, click **BlackBerry Setup**.
- Click **Set Up Wi-Fi**.
- Click **Manually Add Network**.
- Type the network name or service set identifier (SSID) and click **Add**.
- From the Security Type menu, select the security type for the Wi-Fi network.
- Specify the required security credentials and click **Connect**.

To connect to a hotspot, complete the following steps:

- From the homescreen, click **BlackBerry Setup**.
- Click **Set Up Wi-Fi**.
- Click **Scan For Networks**.
- From the list of available Wi-Fi networks, click the appropriate Wi-Fi network.
- Specify the required security credentials and click **Connect**.
- Click **Next**.
- Click **Wi-Fi Hotspot Login** to open the captive portal in the browser and specify the security credentials or payment options.
